<u>First Paragraph</u>

- Begin with a BRIEF description of the setting, activity, or an important person
- **Thesis**: Statement that identifies an event in the past to be important in a particular manner

After my 13th *birthday, I learned that some presents were better left unwrapped.*

There was a time when I believed in beauty, until the orphanage turned me into an old man.

It was when I heard that first note that I realized everything I wanted to be.

Body Paragraphs: Story Example
